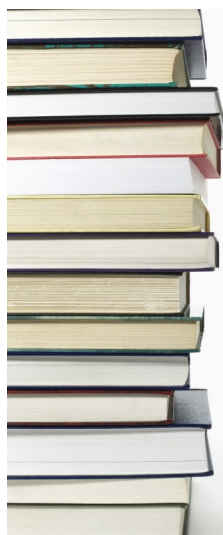

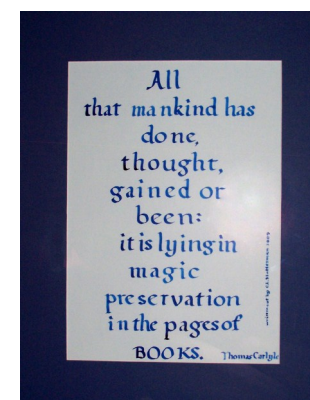

## What is S & I?

The Special and Institutional Section of the Nebraska Library Association (NLA) is one of the Association's six special interest sections. The Special and Institutional Section has been established to reflect the diverse interests of librarians who work in specialized or in institutional libraries.

Our members are employed in a wide variety of libraries throughout Nebraska and include, law, corporate, governmental, prison, church, music, and medical libraries to name only a few. However, membership in the Special and Institutional Section is open to any member of the Nebraska Library Association regardless of the type of library.



## Our Mission

The mission of the Special and Institutional Section is to:

*"Focus on issues and needs affecting libraries in settings such as medical facilities, legal firms, research institutions, corporations, government agencies or specialized services within larger libraries."*



## Our Objectives

1. To provide programming and continuing education opportunities for special library staff.
2. To promote communication and cooperation among special libraries.
3. To advocate for issues and needs of special libraries within the Nebraska Library Association, and to communicate NLA issues and needs to S & I members.
4. To recognize and reward achievements of special library staff.



## Awards

The **Special and Institutional Promotion Award** recognizes outstanding achievements in marketing/promotion of services in Nebraska's special and institutional libraries. Winners may be either libraries or employees. The Distinguished Service award is given to a member(s) in recognition of outstanding service to the Section or to the library profession. The recipient is chosen by the Chairperson.

## S&I Activities

The Special & Institutional Section usually sponsors several programs at the annual NLA conference in October and often sponsors or co-sponsors a program in the spring each year. The section also raises funds to contribute to the Louise Nixon Scholarship fund. In the spring, members also get together informally at a local restaurant to socialize.
